Anfield Gardens

When Josie and Gary moved into their 6.5 acre property in 2010 it only had a few trees consisting of gums and wattles. Now their garden has over 350 trees, mostly made up of ornamentals such as maples, ash, birch, poplars, willows, pears, conifers, planes and pines. With the inclusion of a rare Wollemi pine and also a Lone pine sourced from the Australian War Memorial. There are multiple rose gardens with a preference given to David Austin Roses, along with a vegetable garden, fruit orchard, olive grove, citrus, and a kitchen herb garden. Newly added to the garden is the Shiraz small vineyard, more perennial garden beds and a new arbour to grow wisteria on.

The garden is spread over 2ha, established 11 years ago on a block of paddock grasses and rocky outcrops with no trees. The major trees were planted in the first year and the garden progressively developed. Considerable effort has been put into enriching the thin rocky soil typical of the Windera area. The garden consists predominantly of exotics, with some native species. A spectacular feature of the garden is the area close to the house which showcases the owners talent in transforming a blank canvas into a stunning display. The tree lined driveway is exquisite in spring and autumn.
